- 1. The contest will be run under RSPBA rules.
- 2. Entries and payment to be made via Branch website www.rspba-landb.org/entries
- 3. Entry Fees: All Grades £10.00, Adult D/M's £5.00, Juvenile D/M's £Free
- 4. Bands may play one grade higher. If time permits.
- 5. Closing date for entries is Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> June
- 6. Draw will take place electronically on 25<sup>th</sup> June and will be posted on the following websites: <u>www.rspba.org</u> and <u>www.rspba-landb.org</u>
- 7. Late entries will be accepted and bands will be asked to play first.
- 8. Any band requiring a coach pass must indicate on the online entry where applicable.
- 9. Bands may be asked to play for Drum Majors.
- 10. Bands are expected to take part in the Street Parade and March Past.
