- Entry Fees: All Grades £10.00, Adult D/M's £5.00, Juvenile D/M's £Free**
- Bands may play one grade higher. If time permits.
- Closing date for entries is 29<sup>th</sup> April 2022

- Late entries will be accepted and bands will be asked to play first.
- Any band arriving by coach must indicate on the online entry where applicable for coach pass.
- Bands may be asked to play for Drum Majors.
- Bands are expected to take part in the March Past and Street Parade.
